URUGUAY PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

DAY 1 - MONTEVIDEO Transfer in From Airport to Hotel, with guide Private Half-day City Tour Montevideo







Duration: 3:30 hrs approx.

Experience Uruguay's most cosmopolitan city with little to no walking involved. This panoramic tour will take you past Montevideo's most prominent buildings, parks, monuments, and residential areas. The main attractions of the tour are the Independence Square, where you will see a monument dedicated to national hero, José Gervasio Artigas and his Mausoleum. The Solis Theater and the Government House Museum are located around the square. You will drive down 18 de Julio Avenue which is lined with shops, cafés and office buildings. You will have the opportunity to take photos at the Legislative Palace, the Parliament building where Congress and Senate meet. This impressive building, which was constructed between 1908 and 1925 with 52 kinds of local marble and 12 types of wood, is Uruguay's pride and joy. The option of going inside has an additional cost and is subject to opening as per Parliament Activity. You will drive past Prado neighborhood, home to one of the oldest parks in the city and to the famous *La Diligencia* sculpture & the monument to the last Charrua Indians and later continue to Batlle and Ordoñez Park. On the way you will see the Obelisk, La Carreta monument and the Centenario Soccer Stadium. You will also drive past the residential area of Carrasco and stop at Plaza Virgilio, where you will not only see a monument dedicated to Fallen Navy Soldiers, but also have a great photo opportunity due to the view provided. The drive back will be along the coast of marvelous beaches that Montevideo has right at its doorstep.

Includes: Guide at disposal during the walking tour, transfers from/ to the hotel.

Walk: moderate. There is light walking on this excursion. Walking at the photo-stops is optional and entirely at your discretion.

Note: Please note that a visit to Plaza Matriz may not be possible due to road closures. Because the Legislative Palace is a public building and office, it is subject to closure without prior notice due to parliamentary activities (Optional and additional rate for visit inside). The order in which you go to the different destinations may change to avoid and alleviate traffic jams. We recommend guests wear flat, comfortable shoes.

The hotel provides free daily breakfast and the attention is impeccable.

DAY 2 - MONTEVIDEO - PUNTA DEL ESTE Breakfast at the hotel

Full-day Tour Punta del Este and Casapueblo Museum







Duration: 8:30 hrs approx.

A mere two hours and 85 miles away up the coast from Montevideo, Uruguay's highly praised Punta del Este is found. Many jetsetters come here seeking a short getaway on white-sand beaches and luxury living. Discover Punta and a handful of other beachfront communities on this full-day sightseeing excursion. First, stop at Portezuelo and Punta Ballena, hidden on a bluff overlooking the ocean. You will also stop for a photo opportunity at Casapueblo, the former home of famed Uruguayan artist Carlos Paez Vilaro who passed away in February 2014. The dazzling white complex, resembling Spanish Moroccan architecture, sits on a rocky bluff overlooking the ocean. Vilaró built it in 1958 with his own two hands, using only traditional tools. Narrow steps lead to a maze of rooms scattered on different levels and filled with the artist's works. Entrance to museum is included.

Your next stop will be Punta del Este. Although the resort's colonial architecture has been largely replaced with high-rise hotels and apartments, its residential areas are still graced with elegant beachfront homes and mansions nestled among the tall pines lining the shore. Your next destination is La Barra and its unique hanging bridges. Merrily painted buildings and its cement camelback bridge create a carnival-like atmosphere and is a sight to behold. You will drive downtown where lunch will be served at a local Punta del Este restaurant (optional, not included). If you have time to spare, you will be able to enjoy free time to explore on your own.

Walking involved: this excursion involves going up and down narrow steps inside Casapueblo.

NOTES: The order in which we go to the different destinations may change to avoid and alleviate traffic jams. The timetable may vary slightly depending on traffic (+/- 15 minutes). The timetable could also be affected by public holidays and/or unforeseen circumstances. We recommend guests wear light clothing, sunscreen, a hat and flat comfortable shoes and bring water.

DAY 3 - MONTEVIDEO - COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO

Breakfast at the hotel

Full-day Colonia del Sacramento



Duración: 8 hrs.

Leave Montevideo towards Colonia del Sacrament. You will start with a tour of the surroundings by vehicle. You will pass through the "Rambla" of Colonia, place of spectacular sunsets; Real de San Carlos, the old bullring of Colonia; San Benito Chapel; and the Mihanovich complex, among other historical places in Colonia.

Continuing with the Old City Walking Tour, you will indeed explore and wonder through the cobblestone streets of Old Town Colonia by foot, becoming enchanted with history. Colonia del Sacramento was founded by the Portuguese in 1680, a time when Spain and Portugal were in the midst of conflict. Today, peace reigns as the Old City closes a door onto days long gone, retaining a charm that will be well appreciated on your guided walk.

Matriz Church, Bastión del Carmen, the streets of Santa Rita and San Gabriel and the area of San Pedro Road all beckon with their colonial architecture and flower-bedecked buildings. Calle de los Suspiros, or Street of Sighs, has set the scene for historical films, while Puerta del Campo and Plaza Mayor 25 de Mayo also bring the past into the present, tangible symbols of historic events and enduring traditions. Colonia is a truly delightful place, with its architectural treasures complemented by the natural beauty of its surroundings. The Uruguay River and historic landmarks such as the cathedral, San Carlos bullring and lighthouse offer a magical mix of scenic beauty and cultural significance. At the end of the walking tour, there will be a stop for lunch, shopping or to walk around the city by yourself. After the tour, you will be dropped off at Port to take the ferry to Buenos Aires.

Includes: Walk: moderate, it is not extensive but you will find cobblestone streets during the walking tour. NOTES: The order in which you go to the different sites may change to avoid and/or alleviate traffic. The schedule may be modified depending on traffic (+/- 30 minutes). The schedule may also be affected by public holidays and/or unforeseen circumstances. It is recommended to wear comfortable clothing, sunscreen, a hat, water and comfortable walking shoes.
