IBERÁ NATURAL RESERVE

The Ibera natural Reserve is located in the province of Corrientes, in the northeast of the Argentine Republic, the known ecosystem as Esteros del Iberá must to their name to the Ibera lagoon located in the zone Eastern center of this immense system of humedales. The Iberá word express to the site like "the water that shines", name that supposedly gave to their original guaraníes settlers when observing the crispate brightness him of their surface.

The Iberá marshes are one of the largest moist areas in the world and covers 14% of the Province of Corrientes with a surface area of 1.300.000 hectares.

- It is one of the most important drinking water reserves in the continent and the largest protected area in Argentina.
- Its ornithological wealth includes 350 different bird species.

GETTING THERE

Access is part of the adventure. Hotels in Iberá can be reached by:

- Private overland transfers from Corrientes or Posadas Airports. Exclusive services, including private guide and activities.
- Private air taxi, landing directly on the lodge's private airstrip (weather permitting).

Suggested Accommodation

Rincón del Socorro: Reached via a scenic overland journey of approximately 5 hours from Corrientes Airport, offering a remote and immersive arrival deep within the Iberá Wetlands.

El Tránsito Boutique Hotel: Located at Portal Carambola, it offers the most accessible arrival in Iberá, with overland transfers from approximately 2.5 hs to get there.

Suggested stay: 4 days - 3 nights

Guests are invited to experience life in a traditional estancia while contributing directly to the protection and restoration of the Iberá ecosystem.
