## SANTIAGO , LAKES & PATAGONIA 6 Days / 5 nights

### Day 1 – Santiago – Puerto Montt – Puerto Varas

Arrival at Santiago airport. Assistance from a bilingual guide during your connection with the next flight to Puerto Montt.

Reception at Puerto Montt airport and transfer to the hotel located in Puerto Varas, a beautiful city situated on the shores of Lake Llanquihue and facing the Osorno volcano.

In the Afternoon, **City tour Puerto Montt and Puerto Varas:** We start our travel at Plaza de Armas in Puerto Montt, in there, we will visit the Cathedral and the German Settlers Monument. From Manuel Montt lookout point we will have the chance to contemplate a spectacular panoramic view of the city, the Reloncaví Sound or Seno de Reloncaví; a body of water located immediately south of Puerto Montt and the Tenglo Island. Afterwards, we will visit the picturesque small harbor (Caleta) of Angelmó, the Market, the typical small restaurants and the Craft Fair in which we will be able to find a big amount of different products for purchasing. We will continue our travel to the beautiful city of Puerto Varas, located on the Shore of Llanquihue Lake which offers a breathtaking view of both Osorno Volcano and Mt. Calbuco. We will visit its Plaza de Armas, the Barrio Antiguo, and the Church of The Sacred Heart of Jesus which is an exact replica of one of the churches of the Black Forest of Germany.

### Day 2 – Puerto Varas

In the morning, Half day excursion to **Frutillar:** We will start our excursion by Passing Llanquihue; a city founded by German settlers which is located at the shores of the lake and characterized by its typical German Architecture. We continue our journey towards the ancient Route of the Settlers, bordering Llanquihue Lake we will get to the beautiful city of Frutillar which stands out due to its architecture, its well-maintained gardens and an incomparable view of both Osorno and Puntagudo volcanoes. We will visit the German Colonial Museum which makes and acknowledgement to the German settlers by showing an ancient ranch with five typical constructions made of wood where shingles and beautiful gardens stand out, undoubtedly a wonderful visit through our history

Note: In shared service (SIB), the tour departs at 9am

In the Afternoon: Half day excursion to **Petrohue:** We will start our excursion from the city of Puerto Varas, when bordering the Llanquihue Lake on the way to the waterfalls, we will be able to see the river mouth of Río Pescado (Fish River), the villages of La Poza and Los Riscos until we get to Ensenada. 10 kilometers later we will get to Vicente Perez Rosales National Park, heading for Río Petrohué Waterfalls sector; we will walk along its sidewalks, we will observe how the flowing water of the river splashes among the big masses of crystalized lava which were formed by Osorno Volcano eruptions. We will have an awesome view of the beautiful turquoise waters of the river and of its surroundings. We will finish our tour at the well-known Lake of All Saints (Lago de Todos Los Santos)

Note: In the afternoon, this tour operates only as a private service

### **Day 3 – Puerto Varas – Puerto Montt – Punta Arenas – Puerto Natales**

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Punta Arenas.

Bilingual guide assistance at the airport to board a direct bus from the airport to Puerto Natales (3:15 h journey).

Upon arrival, you will be met at the bus terminal and transferred to your hotel.

### **Day 4 – Puerto Natales**

Full day exc. to **Torres del Paine National Park**: Departure from Puerto Natales through steppes and Patagonia scrub, full of abundant wildlife and herds of sheep, up to Torres del Paine National Park declared world heritage by UNESCO in 1978. In the park, a large variety of native fauna especially large herds of guanacos can be observed. Visit the Salto Grande of the Paine River, with the impressive mountain massif of Torres del Paine in the background. Then visit to Lake Pehoé, Lake Grey and Grey Glacier. Taking the road back to Puerto Natales, a second important visit is made, this time to the **Mylodon Cave**, a Natural Monument where the remains of a prehistoric animal were discovered

**Meals: Breakfast at the hotel + lunch in a local restaurant**

### **Day 5 – Puerto Natales - Santiago**

Transfer to the airport in Puerto Natales on time to board your return flight to Santiago

Reception at the airport and transfer to the hotel

**Overnight in Santiago (Standard room)**

**Meals: Breakfast at the hotel**

### **Day 6 – Santiago**

In the morning, Half day **Panoramic City Tour**: The tour starts by visiting the main streets of the civic neighborhood, meeting on the way the Cerro Santa Lucía (emblematic urban park located in the heart of the city), the seat of the government "Palacio de la Moneda" and the traditional Plaza de Armas, a meeting point where you can see the most diverse and multicultural side of the city and where buildings of high historical value are located such as the Metropolitan Cathedral, the National Historical Museum and the Central Post Office. The tour continues through the Parque Forestal until reaching the Bellavista neighborhood, a sector that brings together the best of the bohemian scene in Santiago

Note: In Private service the tour includes the San Cristobal hill to enjoy a panoramic view of the city and the Andes Mountain (ascent by a shuttle bus and descent by funicular or cable car).

At the agreed time, transfer to the airport to board your next flight
