

Day 01

Santiago (-)

Reception at Santiago's airport and transfer to the hotel.

Rest of the day at leisure to explore the city or to take an optional excursion (not included)

Day 02

Santiago (B)

Breakfast in the hotel.

H/D Panoramic city tour including the main attractions of the city center, such as Cerro Santa Lucía, where the city was founded in 1541; the Government Palace, called “La Moneda”; and the Plaza de Armas, where there are important monuments such as the Central Post Office, the Cathedral of Santiago, and the National Historical Museum. The tour continues to the bohemian neighborhood of Bellavista. Return to the hotel. Overnight.

Note: For passengers in private service, the tour includes San Cristóbal Hill to enjoy a panoramic view of the city and the Andes Mountains, ascending by shuttle bus and descending by funicular or cable car.

Return to the hotel and overnight.



OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS:

- ### H/D Maipo Valley (Concha y Toro Vineyard)

One of the essentials in Santiago de Chile is discovering the largest exporter of wine in the country. You'll depart from the hotel and set course to the Maipo Valley, a sector of the central area known as the wine valley and where the Viña Concha y Toro is located. It's a place that opens its doors to visitors to share the exciting secrets of wine production and of the export process. The tour includes a walk through the beautiful colonial gardens of this company founded in 1883. It is currently considered one of the 10 most important wine producers in the world. A visit to the wineries, to the vineyards themselves (some of which were planted by its founder, Don Melchor Concha y Toro) and, of course, a tasting is also part of the tour.

At the end, you'll have time to make wine purchases before returning to your hotel in Santiago.

- ### F/D Valparaiso & Viña del Mar

Depart in the morning towards the coast, on the way you will cross the famous valley of Casablanca, a sector known for its vineyards. Arriving at the coast, we visit Viña del Mar, the so-called Garden City that, thanks to its beautiful beaches, beautiful parks and floral ornaments like the famous flower clock, has become one of the most representative tourist attractions of the central zone. Mixing the tranquility of the seascape and the modernity of its streets and infrastructure, this city presents itself as an entertaining city that is always in constant movement.

Afterwards, we visit the picturesque city port of Valparaíso. This city, founded in the sixteenth century, marks a perfect contrast to the previous panorama as it replaces the modern and beach spirit of Viña with a much more popular and handcrafted city. This port, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2003, offers a unique and fascinating architecture: The city is located next to several hills, which can be accessed through narrow streets, long stairs and various elevators, built between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th. The hills are covered in houses that have been painted in different colors and that form an irresistible landscape for lovers of photography and heritage neighborhoods. At the end of the tour, return to the hotel in Santiago.
