04D/03N: BOGOTÁ, COLOMBIA



Bogotá is the capital of Colombia. It is a point of convergence of people from all over the country, so it is diverse and multicultural, where the old and the modern are combined. When visiting the city, you will be able to marvel at the charm of its architecture; you will find its different styles thanks to this fusion between past and present. Bogota is an ideal destination with history, fun, gastronomy, culture, business, and much more.



OUTLINED PROGRAM BOGOTA – COLOMBIA 4D/3N

DAY 1 – BOGOTA: Reception and transfer from the International Airport of Bogotá to the hotel of your choice. Overnight.

DAY 2 – BOGOTA “City tour with Monserrate”: Breakfast. A staff member from the company will meet you at the hotel to take you on a tour around the historic center of the city. The first stop will be at Plaza de Bolivar to walk along the streets and take a close look of the most important buildings of the city, such as the National Capitol, which is the center of the country's legislative life; “Casa de los Comuneros”; Casa de Nariño, which is the Presidential house; and the Santa Clara Church Museum. The tour includes a visit to the Gold Museum, which exhibits about 34,000 pieces of metalwork from various Hispanic cultures and if time permits, a tour will be made to the Casa de la Moneda Museum. The tour continues to the iconic symbol of Bogota, the Monserrate Hill rising to 3,152 above sea level, to visit the sanctuary where you will find the statue of the Lord of Monserrate. From there it is possible to enjoy the best view of Bogota.

Duration: About 05 hours approximately.

Operation: The regular service operates from Monday to Saturday starting at 8:00 Hrs.

Notes: Gold museum and Quinta de Bolivar are **closed on Mondays**, instead we visit Museo de Botero and Museo Casa de la Moneda. The Casa de la Moneda Museum is closed on Tuesdays. On Sunday, this tour operates subject to availability and upon request.

DAY 3 - BOGOTA “Salt Cathedral Tour”: " A staff member from the company will meet you at the hotel, either in the morning or the afternoon, to take you on a tour through La Sabana de Bogota to the town of Zipaquirá, which name means 'city of our Father' in the language of the Chibcha. Salt in pre-Columbian times, salt around the area was the most important commodity and the ‘salt cakes’ were the only currency for trading. Over time, technology improved and the muisca began to extract larger amounts of salt. As a result, an underground salt deposit was formed and it is where the Salt Cathedral was built, 180 meters below the surface. Inside, there is a chapel, “capilla de los mineros” built as a tribute to the Virgin “Our Lady of the Rosary of Guasá” (Guasá means 'mine' in Chibcha). At the end, return to Bogotá. This tour is not recommended for people with mobility restrictions.

Duration: 05 hours approximately.

Operation: The regular service operates from Monday to Sunday starting at 8:00 a.m.

DAY 4 – BOGOTA: Breakfast. Pick-up and transfer to the airport as scheduled to take a flight to reach the next city or your destination.
