FULL DESCRIPTION

DAY 01: LIMA

Arrival in Lima. Private escorted transfer to your hotel.

Optional tour: We will have a panoramic view of the main streets, squares, and avenues of the city. We will start with a panoramic view of the Miraflores district, beginning in the Parque del Amor, where we will observe the famous sculpture "The Kiss" by the Peruvian artist Victor Delfin. Next, we will observe the impressive Huaca Pucllana, a ceremonial center of the Lima culture. We will continue to the Plaza de Armas, where we will find the Government Palace and the Municipal Palace. We will visit the Cathedral and then walk to the Convent of Santo Domingo, whose corridors were walked by San Martín de Porres and Santa Rosa de Lima in the 17th century and where their remains currently lie.

Tour duration: 3,5 hours.

Guests must arrive in Lima no later than 11 AM to be able to take this tour in the afternoon.

Overnight stay in Lima.

DAY 02: LIMA / CUSCO (B/L)

Private assisted airport transfer. Arrival in Cusco and begin your tour from the airport (**please consider arriving in Cusco at 9AM at the latest**).

Private FD tour of Sacred Valley (7 hours). We will visit the most outstanding sites of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. We will leave for the town of Chinchero, the most typical and picturesque of the Sacred Valley. This town is also famous for its women weavers, we will make a brief stop in a textile center to appreciate its beautiful fabrics and where they will teach us

the ancient Inca techniques for dyeing and spinning with Alpaca wool. In the town of Chinchero we will visit its Inca archaeological complex and its beautiful colonial church enjoying the impressive natural images that surround the town. We will continue to Moray, a beautiful and curious Inca archaeological complex composed of colossal concentric terraces simulating a large amphitheater. In Incas times, it served as an agricultural laboratory where diverse microclimates were recreated. Lunch at one of the restaurants in the area. Finally, we end our tour visiting the fabulous archaeological complex of Ollantaytambo, which was important for the Incas as a military, religious and agricultural center. We will visit the Temple of the ten windows, the bathrooms of the ñusta, the Temple of the Sun among other places of interest. The postcards from the heights of Ollantaytambo will close on this magical day in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Overnight stay in Sacred Valley.

DAY 03: CUSCO / MACHU PICCHU / CUSCO (B/L)

Morning private transfer to the Ollantaytambo train station (Spanish-speaking driver only, transfer duration: approximately 1 hour). You will depart by Vistadome train to visit one of the 7 Wonders of the World. Upon arrival at the Aguas Calientes (Machu Picchu Pueblo) station, you will meet your private local English-speaking guide to board a shuttle bus. The bus will ascend by an intricate path, offering spectacular views of the Urubamba River that shapes the famous canyon. The Lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu, will welcome us with its incredible terraces, stairways, ceremonial precincts, and urban areas. The energy emanating from the entire site is palpable. The tour duration is approximately 2.5 hours. After the tour, you will board a shuttle bus to return to Machu Picchu Pueblo. A buffet lunch will be provided at a local restaurant in Machu Picchu Pueblo. You will then board a Vistadome train back to Ollantaytambo. Upon arrival, a private transfer will take you from Ollantaytambo station to your Cusco hotel (Spanish-speaking driver only, transfer duration: approximately 2 hours). Overnight stay in Cusco.

DAY 04: CUSCO (B)

Private HD tour of Cusco and Sacsayhuaman archaeological park (3,5 hours). We will drive up to the Archaeological Park of Sacsayhuamán. Our excursion starts by visiting the magnificent fortress, a beautiful place that radiates peace and quiet. We will admire the rocks, measuring up to 4 meters high, that were used in its construction. Then, we will continue to Q'enqo, an ancient temple of the cougar, which has an altar for sacrifices inside the rock. Next, we will visit Tambomachay, the sacred fountains of life and health. On the way, we will have a panoramic view of Puca Pucara, a watchtower that controlled the entrance to the city. After that, we will visit the Temple of the Sun, "Korikancha," on top of which the Santo Domingo Convent was built. Legend has it that this temple was entirely lined in gold sheets that marveled the Conquistadors upon their arrival. Finally, we will end our tour by visiting the Cathedral, located opposite the main square, which holds invaluable colonial paintings and other works of religious art, such as the Cross that arrived with the first conquerors.

Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight stay in Cusco.

DAY 05: CUSCO (B)

Private assisted airport transfer.

All transfers, visits and excursions have been quoted in private service with local English-speaking guides and assistants (during the transfers), except for the train and bus to Machu Picchu and back which are provided on a shared basis).
